The Catholic Foundation of Santa Clara County has been developing and managing endowed and other funds since 2005. We have distributed \$9.5M to parishes during that time.

Adding *COMMUNITY* to our name indicates our vision to become an umbrella for Catholic philanthropy in our valley, continuing the development of funds that strengthen the Catholic organizations and ministries that we love. We will work to match philanthropic intent with unmet need in our Catholic community.

WHAT'S THE SAME:

We will continue managing and granting from our legacy funds. Donors may still contribute to these ministries through the Foundation.

WHAT'S NEW:

Under the Catholic Community Foundation umbrella we will provide additional options for Catholic philanthropy:

- Designated endowments: set up to support 1-5 named beneficiaries. These could be set up by individuals in support of organizations, or by Catholic organizations themselves.
- Field of Interest endowments: organized around a specific area of need, and managed through an open application process, similar to the current competitive application process of the foundation.
- Donor advised funds: vehicles for broad giving, primarily to Catholic organizations.
